Each Young Writers Summer Camp will end with a celebration of writing, the first on Friday evening, August 7th, and the second on Thursday evening, August 13th, at Olbrich. Young writers will share their favorite pieces of writing from the week for their families and friends. During the camp, writers are expected to bring their own sack lunches.

Writers can expect to:

- Write daily in a beautiful environment, using the gardens as inspiration for writing.
- Write in a supportive environment, led by a staff of Greater Madison Writing Project Summer Institute Fellows and experienced teachers of writing whose goal is to inspire and support writers of all abilities.
- Engage in the writing process (generating ideas, drafting, revising, editing and publishing) while exploring a variety of genres, including poetry, creative nonfiction, personal narratives and short stories.
- Meet young writers from the Madison area and share writing with them each day during 'Author's Chair.'
- Learn new writing techniques and ways to respond to writing through peer review and writing groups.
- Meet guest writers from the Madison area.
- · Contribute a piece of writing to be published in an anthology.

In addition to having fun and learning, writers will receive:

- Young Writers Summer Camp t-shirt.
- Print copy of the anthology published from the camp.

Early Bird Registration for the camps are due by June 1st at the reduced rate of \$150. After June 1st, registration is \$200. The registration period runs until July 1st.
